



Arno Wicki is Assistant Director General and Head of the Division for Asia - Americas at the Swiss Agency for Development and Cooperation (SDC). Between 2018 and 2022, he was Ambassador of Switzerland to the Republic of Chile. Before, he was Deputy Head of Swiss Humanitarian Aid at SDC. His responsibilities included among others the Swiss Government's contributions to and relations with the leading international humanitarian organizations. Earlier, Arno Wicki was Head of Government and Industry Affairs for Europe at the Zurich Insurance Group. He was responsible for managing Zurich's interactions with the EU institutions, regional industry bodies and the relevant actors in EU member States. He advised executives on public policy issues impacting Zurich's operations in Europe. Prior to that, he was Counsellor for Economic and Latin American Affairs at the Embassy of Switzerland in Washington DC. As a Swiss diplomat, he also held positions at the Swiss Permanent Mission to the United Nations in Geneva, the Embassy of Switzerland in Madrid and at the Foreign Minister's Office in Bern. Before joining the Foreign Service, he worked for the United Nations in New York and Haiti as a political affairs officer. Arno Wicki graduated from the University of Lausanne in Political Science. He also holds Master's degrees in International Relations from the University of Miami and Complutense University in Madrid. He is married and has three children.
